3. Principal's Update	Tracy Foster -507 students 35 PPs, changes daily/weekly - Continue to have new students almost weekly. From all over world. - All classes at or very near cap. - We have Schools Plus (a community outreach worker (Erin Grinnell) and a lead (Bernice Arthur and Rebekah VandenHoogan-CYCP) a hub of services for parents, schools and students to access; a collaborative service delivery model. - Entry is also working really well. Still some issues with cars passing bus and cars pulling in on wrong side of Sunnybrae. - To date we have had two fire drills, Lockdown and Hold and Secure drill. Relocation and Bus evacuations will happen as per Emergency Management Protocols - Strings and Band have just started. - Choir at lunch once a week – Wed at lunch- grades 4-6 - Breakfast Baskets-for now- volunteers from the mount. Mrs. Carter is heading the program. - SSP Goals: Literacy: Students will strengthen literacy skills and demonstrate improved reading comprehension. Math: Students will demonstrate improvement in number sense with an emphasis on partitioning and representing numbers. Well-Being Goal: We will improve student well-being at our school. This continues to be our fall focus. Getting to know students and families, cultures, beliefs and values. We're doing a monthly theme.
