- 539 students including 34 PPs next year some schools are getting 3 year olds. We don't know which schools.
- Continue to have new students almost weekly. From all over world.
- All classes at or over cap. Iain is at 28. P/1 English classes are both 1 over cap.
- Online Learning was a success. We signed out our technology through the library this time. 175 devices. We still have about 20-30 out. We need them back and will send a message out to families because we need them.
- Students are doing fairly well with mask wearing and hand sanitizing. We have been being very strict about this.
- Staff shortages- support teachers and Admin have covered classes. Lunch monitors have come in before and after lunch to help in the LC.
- Breakfast Baskets-continue
